

Highlights of the FY 2005 President's Budget for Oak Ridge Operations

- **The FY 2005 budget for Oak Ridge Operations is \$1.9 billion - 12 percent of DOE's \$15.3 billion request.**
- **The proposed budget is \$77 million higher (or 4 percent) than FY 2004 budget.**
- **The SNS project is fully funded, but reduced by \$28 million as planned. SNS is on schedule for completion in FY 2006 and is within budget.**
- **EM budget includes a \$50 million increase in Uranium/Thorium payments and a \$40 million increase for the Oak Ridge Environmental Management program. Paducah and Portsmouth site funding is no longer included in the Oak Ridge EM budget.**
- **Nuclear Energy funding will increase \$10 million to support the U-233 Disposition Project.**
- **NNSA funding for the Y-12 National Security Complex is not included in this budget.**
