Oak Ridge Contractor Relationships

- DOE activities in Oak Ridge are multi-program, multi-site, and multi-contractor.
- A DOE/Contractor Coordinating Council is established to foster communications, coordination and cooperation (Section H-37)
- Effective interactions among the OR prime contractor are essential. Interface examples:
 - » Working with the M&I contractor Bechtel Jacobs in delivery of characterized, certified waste.
 - » Supporting DOE in Oak Ridge Reservation land use management and land management activities
 - » Supporting non-proliferation efforts through the Y-12 National Security Project Office



Oak Ridge Contractor Relationships

- Where there is net benefit to DOE, one prime contractor may perform services for another prime contractor. This may occur when the Contractor so elects or when DOE directs that a particular function or task be performed by one contractor for all OR contractors (Section H-36).



Transition

- Phase in period is from February 1 to March 31, 2000
- It is DOE's expectation that efforts considered by the Contractor necessary for compliance with any inspections referenced in the clause entitled "Pre-existing Conditions" (Section I-137) will primarily be conducted after 4/1/2000
- On 4/1/2000 all non-key LMER personnel will become employees of the Contractor



Transition

- RFP requests transition plan that addresses at a minimum:
 - » Management team
 - » Process for assuming control of laboratory functions
 - » Incumbent contractor employee transitioning
 - » Acceptance of subcontracts and other agreements and commitments
 - » Continuing high productivity and positive labor-management relations
 - » Conducting transition in effective and cost efficient manner

- RFP also requests a master prioritized list and schedule of major activities
