The Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant Citizens Advisory Board has reviewed the proposed Accelerated Cleanup Plan, dated June 18, 2002, for the Paducah site from the Department of Energy. The board does not endorse the June 18, 2002 Department of Energy Plan, but agrees with the concept of an accelerated cleanup for the Paducah site only if the following are taken into consideration:

- A) The public is allowed reasonable time to review, comment and participate in decisions made regarding clean up.
- B) Department of Energy gives serious consideration and provides timely response to all past and future recommendations submitted by the board.
- C) Long-term stewardship issues are noted in decision documents for actions done under an accelerated clean up.
- D) The lines of communication stay open and clear.
- E) The endorsement by the board does not preclude the board's right to agree/disagree with the proposed decisions regarding specific projects or actions at the Paducah site.
