SUBJECT: **VOLUNTARY SOLICITATION - QUALITY ASSURANCE ENGINEER, GS-13**

TO: All ORO and National Nuclear Security Administration, OR, Employees

The Office of Assistant Manager for Defense Programs, National Nuclear Security Administration, has a vacancy for a Quality Assurance Engineer in the Operations Management Group. The incumbent of the position monitors and evaluates the adequacy of the Production Agency's (PA) nuclear weapons quality program for development, pre-production, production, testing, inspection, and certification processes and operations in accordance with the requirement of Quality Criteria-1 (QC-1) and the Quality Assurance Procedures Manual; investigates quality and manufacturing problems and assures appropriate corrective actions for very complex products and processes; reviews, interprets, and provides policy guidance to the PA (contractor), and provides recommendations to solve problem areas.

This position is included in the Technical Qualifications Program. The selectee must complete the program and maintain certification to remain in this position. This position is also included in the Personnel Security Assurance Program (PSAP). As such, the selectee will be required to undergo a polygraph test, medical and psychological examinations, and drug testing. No employee will be appointed to this position prior to providing written consent to participate in PSAP.

Consideration for this position will be given to employees who are currently at the GS-13 grade level. Candidates must meet the qualification standards for the placement in the GS-801 series at the GS-13 level. If you wish to be considered for reassignment to this position, you may do so by visiting the Human Resources Division web site at www.oro.doe.gov/pmab. Click on the employment icon and scroll to the area designated as Voluntary Solicitation. Employees who have registered in the Voluntary Solicitation database by June 2, 2000, and who meet established criteria, i.e., qualifications and time-in-grade, will be considered for this position.
