As an undergraduate, he studied mathematics, computer science, and physics, and has a Master’s in computer science from the University of Tennessee. Mr. Cain is presently serving as a senior staff member to the International Safeguards Group in the Nuclear Security & Isotope Technology Division at Oak Ridge National Laboratory. In this role, he is Project Manager in development of several nonproliferation information systems, participates in the DOE International Nuclear Safeguards and Engagement Program, and oversees the DOE Additional Protocol Reporting System.

Mr. Cain’s professional certifications include the Institute of Certified Professional Manager’s Certified Manager, the Project Management Institute’s Project Management Professional, and Microsoft’s Microsoft Certified Systems Engineer.
