**B-1. Services Being Acquired**

The Contractor shall manage and operate the Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL or Laboratory), a Federally Funded Research and Development Center (FFRDC). The Contractor shall provide the necessary personnel, equipment, materials, supplies, and services (except as may be provided by the Government) and otherwise do all things necessary for, or incident to, performing the Statement of Work set forth in Section C as directed by the Contracting Officer within the scope of this contract, or as may be agreed upon by the Contractor and the Contracting Officer.

There shall be no adjustment in the amount of the available fee by reason of differences between any estimate of cost for performance of the work under this contract and the actual costs for performance of that work. The fee available and paid under this clause shall be applicable to the prime contractor and its members in a joint venture or limited liability company, teaming partner, and subcontractors identified and considered a part of the selection and award of this contract, if any.

(c) Determination of Total Available Fee Earned.

- (1) Not exceed the DOE policy on fee for laboratories in effect at the time DOE exercises the option, and
- (2) Be consistent with the approach used in the basic term of the contract.
