

## Oak Ridge Management and Operating (M&O) Contractor Unallowable Fines and Penalties (1992-Present)

1998	LMES	\$111K	Settlement for alleged hazardous waste violation at Portsmouth, Ohio.
1996	LMES	\$ 23K	Penalty for alleged hazardous waste violations.
1994	LMES	\$200K	Penalty assessed.
1994	LMES	\$135K	Penalty assessed by DOT for alleged violations of hazardous materials transportation regulations.
1994	LMES	\$ 5K	Penalty paid to resolve NOV for RCRA paperwork alleged violations at Paducah, Ky.
1993	LMES	\$ 31K	Penalty assessed by DOT for alleged violations of hazardous materials transportation regulations

Notes: All three Oak Ridge facilities (ORNL, Y-12 and ETP) were operated by LMES until 1996.

Three penalties not shown during this period were waived when DOE agreed to perform other in-kind actions.

Fine and penalty values provided above were paid with contractor, not DOE funds. In some of the cases, DOE did pay a portion of the assessment or considered a portion of the assessment allowable cost (that figure is not
